### Beautification Award

The Beautification Award honors individuals, businesses, schools, and organizations whose ongoing efforts enhance and preserve the natural beauty of our environment.

### Urban Forestry Award

The Urban Forestry Award honors individuals, businesses, schools, and organizations that promote a tree conscious community and shows how preserving our resources enhance the quality of life.

### Litter Prevention/Cleanup Award

Litter Prevention Award honors individuals, businesses, schools, and organizations that give emphasis to promoting good stewardship by reducing or preventing litter blight within our community.

### Community Improvement Award

The Community Improvement Award honors individuals, businesses, schools, and organizations who have improved a neighborhood's cleanliness and aesthetics through litter prevention, waste minimization and beautification projects that place emphasis on environmental stewardship.

### Iron Eyes Cody Award

#### In recognition of Mr. Lonnie Jackson
