### ADDENDUM NUMBER TWO WARM SPRINGS BIKE TRAIL – COOPER CREEK BRIDGE & FLAT ROCK PARK BRIDGE

Vendors are informed that the referenced Request for Bids (RFB) is hereby modified, corrected or supplemented as specified, described and set forth in this Addendum.

#### A. PROPOSAL FORMS:

This bid has now been changed from a Lump Sum Bid to a Unit Price Bid.

1. Delete pages IB-8 and IB-9 of the Bid Documents.
2. Add revised pages IB-8, IB-8a, IB-8b, IB-8c, IB-8d, and IB-9 to the Bid Documents.

#### B. ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS/RESPONSES

Question 1: Is a Bridge Foundation Investigation available to help determine pile lengths?

Response: Bidders should use the anticipated rock elevations noted on the drawings to assist with pile lengths.

Question 2: How does the contractor bid the spread footing, if required?

Response: See the revised proposal forms for the spread footing pay item.

Question 3: is there a BFI (Bridge Foundation Investigation) or other soil boring information available for the two bridge locations?

Response: See response to question 1. Soil borings were conducted only on the trail bed and indicated rock beds not encountered. Bidders are encouraged to visit the creek beds at the two project sites for further considerations.

Question 4      The specifications state that the bridge deck is to be lightweight concrete and the plans do not specify whether the concrete will be lightweight or normal weight. Is there a preference or is this to be determined by bridge supplier? Part 4 4.3

Response:      Submittals from the bridge supplier will help determine final bridge slab specification.

Question 5:      Can shop drawings be submitted electronically?

Response:      Shop drawings can be submitted electronically.

Question 6:      If the bridge contractor is responsible for improving access to the site by clearing, grubbing and grading of the existing rail bed, what erosion control measures will be required along rail bed? Who will be responsible for design, installation, maintenance and removal of erosion control devices?

Response:      Contractor is responsible for installing and maintaining any needed soil erosion control measures created by his operation. Pay item 'Civil and Site work' on the bid proposal sheet should cover the cost for this work.

5. The undersigned acknowledges that completing the project within the time limits stated above is of primary concern to the Owner and that failure to meet specified date will constitute an agreed upon payment of \$500.00 per day to the Owner in liquidated damages.
6. The undersigned acknowledges that the Owner reserves the right to award the project on the basis of the **Total Unit Price Bid** and reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive all technicalities and informalities.

The undersigned acknowledges that the total unit price bid equals the summation of all the unit prices listed on pages 8a thru 8d, with the understanding that such unit prices are firm and binding and are to be used to adjust the Contract amount for additions to or deductions from the Scope of Work.
