The following question was submitted:

1. **Question:** "Line 6-states the minimum base to be 14" x 14". Would you accept a cone with a base of 13.68" x 13.68?"

Answer: No.

2. **Question:** "Line 9, Line 10, Line 13, Line 14 -what is the legend? Custom legends incur custom fees and longer lead times."

Answer: We use a variety of types and sizes of legend such as Men Working, Worker's Ahead, Road Work Ahead, Flagman Ahead, Flagger Symbol, Men Working Symbol Right Lane Closed and Left Lane Closed.


3. **Question:** "Line 11, Line 12, Line 15, Line 16 -which sign stand will these be used with? There are a variety of ribs offered depending on the stand in which it will be used."

Answer: Please refer to the specifications on page 15 of 21 under "Ribs For Signs".

4. **Question:** "Line 18-how far off the ground would you like the sign? Do you want to use the ribs as the mast or do you want an aluminum mast?"

Answer: 12" min standard by federal government. We currently use the ribs as the mast but vendor needs to bid what is available through them.
