Amend Specifications to include:

EROSION PREVENTION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES

In order to protect adjacent properties and nearby water features such as creeks, lakes, etc. from the effects of erosion and sedimentation, the area disturbed by the demolition activity (to include the footprint of the demolished structure and surrounding areas), shall be treated as an area affected by any other land disturbing activity and shall adhere to the provisions of Unified Development Ordinance, in particular, Section 8.4.6 - Minimum Requirements for Erosion and Sedimentation Control.

Sediment control measures for demolition sites shall include at a minimum, Type "A" or "C" silt fence around the perimeter of the demolition site (type and number of rows dependant on the characteristics of the site and the site's proximity to Waters of the State of Georgia) as well as mulching and seeding with permanent vegetation or mulching and seeding with a combination of temporary and permanent vegetation as required once the debris has been removed from the site and the final grade has been established.
