Lots containing 7500 square feet or less require one tree to be planted which may be located anywhere on the lot.

Lots containing 7500 square feet or greater require two trees one of which must be a large maturing canopy tree and one which must be located between the street Right –Of-Way and the front building line.

Minimum caliper size for Large Maturing Canopy Trees is Two Inches as measured six inches above the root ball soil line.

Minimum size for Small Maturing Trees is 1.5 Inches as measured six inches above the root ball soil line.

To determine the caliper of Multi-Stem trees, measure each stem at six inches above the root ball soil line and add together.
