<b>COURSE</b>	<b>Bloodborne Pathogens Training: Preventing Disease Transmission Instructor</b>
<b>Course Code</b>	<b>3265I</b>
<b>Purpose</b>	To train instructor candidates to teach the <i>American Red Cross Bloodborne Pathogens Training: Preventing Disease Transmission</i> course. This course prepares instructor candidates to use course materials, conduct training sessions and evaluate the progress of participants in a basic-level course.
<b>Prerequisites</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be at least 17 years of age on or before the last scheduled session of the course. (Candidates must provide proof of age, which can be a driver's license, state ID card, birth certificate or passport.).</li> <li>• Have successfully completed the Fundamentals of Instructor Training course in the last 12 months.</li> <li>• Complete the self-study pre test with a minimum score of 80 percent (40 correct answers out of 50 questions).</li> </ul>
<b>Learning Objectives</b>	<p>This course is designed to prepare instructor candidates to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teach the Bloodborne Pathogens Training: Preventing Disease Transmission course;</li> <li>• Ensure they have the appropriate level of knowledge and teaching skills to successfully teach this basic information to others;</li> <li>• Develop and refine teaching proficiencies;</li> <li>• Understand administrative procedures;</li> <li>• Demonstrate the characteristics required of an American Red Cross representative and role model;</li> <li>• Plan, organize and conduct the Bloodborne Pathogens Training: Preventing Disease Transmission course;</li> <li>• Ensure participants' health and safety during training; and</li> <li>• Maintain complete and accurate records and reports.</li> </ul>
<b>Length</b>	Approximately 4 hours
<b>Instructor</b>	Currently authorized Bloodborne Pathogens Training, Lifeguarding or Emergency Response instructor trainer.
<b>Certification Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Attend and participate during all course sessions.</li> <li>• Successfully complete one practice-teaching assignment.</li> <li>• Pass the final instructor written exam with a score of 80 percent or better.</li> </ul>
<b>Certificate Issued and Validity Period</b>	Bloodborne Pathogens Training: Preventing Disease Transmission Instructor - Authorization is for 2 calendar years. All authorizations expire on December 31. Initial authorization may be less or more depending on when training is completed.
