TRAVEL BALL CONTRACT

This contract is between the “Travel Ball Coach” and Columbus Consolidated Government – Parks and Recreation. It is valid for 1 year and must be renewed at the Preseason Kick-off Dinner/Meeting or thereafter. This contract establishes a guideline of operation in exchange for the use of Columbus Consolidated Government owned fields.

- All teams must register with the Athletic Division of Parks and Recreation before any practices may occur.
 - Must show documentation that the team is registered with a nationally recognized sanctioning body.
 - If not there will be a \$15 fee to register the team with the Amateur Softball Association (ASA) for insurance purposes.
 - If registered with any nationally recognized sanctioning body other than ASA, you must present documentation that you have a \$1,000,000 Liability Insurance Policy.
 - Must fill out the Travel Ball Contact Sheet. (Must list contact information for 2 Individuals and Team Information)
- All teams must abide by the Travel Permit Policy.
 - Includes
 - List of Coaching Contacts
 - List of Player and Their Birthdates
 - Tournament Information
 - Must be delivered to Athletic Division of Parks & Recreation prior to departure.
- Coaches must adhere to the coaching standards and ethics outlined by the National Alliance of Youth Sports (NAYS)
 - This does not mean you have to be NAYS Certified.
- Any games or tournaments to be held on Columbus Consolidated Government owned fields must be contracted through the Athletic Division of Parks & Recreation.
 - General Field
 - \$50.00 per field per day.
 - Must have a \$1,000,000 Liability Insurance Policy for the event.
 - South Commons
 - \$500.00 non-refundable deposit
 - \$800.00 per day.
 - Must have a \$1,000,000 Liability Insurance Policy for the event.
- As a representative of the City of Columbus I will act accordingly as not to bring shame or disgrace to the City of Columbus.
