- <u>VANS, CARS, AND TRUCKS ARE NOT ALLOWED</u> UNLESS THEY ARE PULLING A FLOAT. EXCEPTIONS ARE: ANTIQUE VEHICLES (MODELS YEAR 1988 OR BEFORE) 1<sup>st</sup> PLACE WINNERS OF THE COLUMBUS POLICE DEPARTMENT SPONSORED CAR SHOW WILL BE ALLOWED. (NO ONE MAY RIDE IN THE BACK OF ANY VEHICLE PULLING A FLOAT).
- NO ENTRY MAY USE A SANTA CLAUS. SANTA WILL HAVE HIS OWN FLOAT.
- MEDIA VANS MAY PARTICIPATE -IF THE VAN IS EQUIPPED WITH A PUBLIC ADDRESS SYSTEM, IT MAY ONLY BE USED TO PLAY CHRISTMAS MUSIC.
- NON-PROFESSIONAL FLOATS WILL BE JUDGED AT 8:30 A.M. PROMPTLY.
- <u>CONVERTIBLES MAY ONLY BE USED FOR BEAUTY QUEENS, GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS, ETC. NOT TO EXCEED 3 RIDERS AND ONE DRIVER.</u>
- <u>ALL</u> UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES PARKED IN THE PARADE LINE-UP AREA WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNER'S EXPENSE. <u>NO EXCEPTIONS!</u>
- ALL HORSE ENTRIES MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST NOT MORE THAN 12 MONTHS PRIOR TO ENTRY AND A CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE NOT MORE THAN 30 DAYS PRIOR TO ENTRY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE CODE OF ALABAMA 80 - 3-4.6 AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA 40 - 13-3 - .03, .06
