**I. CALL TO ORDER**

**III. REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS**

**NEW CASES:**

1. **HD 0802-02 – 1311 Peacock Avenue:** Jack Jenkins, Applicant. Request permission to expand master suite and rear courtyard. After a brief discussion, approval was given to build addition with a slight change in the material in fence going from wood to all brick. Don Beall made a motion to approve the application with the minor change in the fence. Virginia Peebles seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
2. **HD 0802-03 – 745 Broadway:** Keith Harnage, Applicant. Request permission to replace existing fence with 8' wood privacy fence, add arbor, remove brick steps and install wood landing, stamped concrete patio and build

small tool shed. After a brief discussion about height of fence and size of double gate Virginia Peebles made a motion to approve the application as submitted and Don Beall seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.

3. **HD 0802-05 – 828 Overlook Drive:** Teresa & Trip Tomlinson, Applicants. Request permission to replace patio doors and side windows. After a brief discussion, Sia Etemadi made a motion to approve the application as submitted. Don Beall seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.
4. **HD 0802-04 – 429 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue:** Historic Columbus Foundation, Applicant. Request permission to demolish rear of house that has been destroyed by fire. After a brief discussion, Don Beall made a motion to approve the application as submitted. Barbara Pound seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously.




Don Beall talked about the Georgia Department of Museums and Galleries.
