Whitesville/Double Churches Intersection improvements, Fort Benning/Brennan Realignment, Fort Benning Streetscape, State Rd. Projects I-185 Widening, I-185/Victory Gateway .  
Technology Parkway, Brown Ave. Bridges, Talbotton Rd. Widening, Old Moon Rd. Resurfacing, Veterans Parkway Widening.
