
**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE COLUMBUS SECTION OF THE FY 2008-



WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Columbus section of the FY 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include the following project.

P.I. Number 0008185 – Veteran’s Streetscape – Phase II (10th Street to 13th Street). Shift funding from Enhancement (TE, L220) Lump Sum to Stimulus Funds (C230) and change logical termini from SR 520 to 10th Street. The amount of Federal Funding is \$1,250,000.00 (100% with no match).




WHEREAS it is necessary to amend the Columbus section of the FY 2008-2011 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) to include the following project.
