Who is eligible for WIOA Services?

Individuals who are:

- Unemployed;
- Employed less than full-time and are seeking full-time employment;
- In a position not commensurate with their skills;
- Working full-time and are not earning a sufficient wage;
- Employed, but whose current job earnings are not sufficient compared to their previous earnings;
- Transitioning out of the Armed Forces;
- Youth between the ages of 16 and 24.
